

Carpenters line to the Courfe on the Braunt side till it intersect a North line drawn from a White Oak at the
 side of part my Braunt. Thence with a line drawn South to the said White Oak at part my Braunt, and from thence
 bounded down the said Braunt to the first boundary, containing by Estimation Two hundred forty five Acres

 they the said Eliz: Toob, John: Toob & Matthew: his wife doth acknowledge & that of & of every part & portion
 thereof, do: hereby expone, acquit & discharge the said Hannah: Carpenter her Heirs and Assigns for ever by these
 presents, have given granted, bargained, sold, aliened, freed and confirmed, and by these presents for them sold their
 Heirs, Executors & Assigns do: freely & absolutely, give grant, alien, sell, release & confirm unto her the said Hannah
 Carpenter her Heirs and Assigns a part or portion of Land, taken out of the said tract of Land called Wiltoms bounded
 as followeth, beginning at a marked History, standing by the main Braunt of Cat Creek, on the East or most side
 of a small Braunt issuing from the said Main Braunt & running its Course with a North parallel line quite through the
 Land of the said Toob called Wiltoms Cont: by estimation fifty Acres more or less & is now called addition to free
 purchase, together with all privileges thereunto belonging Royall immunities excepted. To have and to
 hold the said fifty Acres of Land and premises called addition to free purchase with the appurtenances therein
 or hereby mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold unto her the said Hannah: Carpenter her Heirs and
