 and especially for the love and love I bear unto my Daughter Rebecca born of my loving wife Patience
 Williams, do give unto my said Daughter Rebecca William's And by these presents do absolutely and
 freely give unto my said Daughter Rebecca Cus (as to me only called young Britz bonny of a brown colour
 and with more her belly with a star in her forehead, ear marked viz. Cropt on the right and a nitch
 under each ear and a slit in the cropt, also one young Mars about two year old bonny of a brownish
 colour, ear marked, viz. Cropt on the right ear and a nitch under each ear and a slit in the cropt. To
 have and to hold the said Cus and young Mars with their increase both Males and females to her the
 said Rebecca and to her Heirs and assigns for ever, always provided that my said Daughter shall
 not dispose of the said Cus nor Mars nor any of their increase, until she attaineth to the age of six
 teen years or the day of her marriage. that they remain and run with my own until then and always
 provided notwithstanding the said gift freely given it shall be at my dispose if they increase to many
 to sell part of them for the use and benefit still of my said Daughter Rebecca. In Witness whereof I have
 above written of the said Michael Williams do hereunto set my mark & affix my seal this four
 teenth day of July in the sixth year of their Ma^{ties} Queen William and Mary by the Grace of God of
 England Scotland France and Ireland King and Queen of the faithfull etc. Anno Domini

This Indenture witnesseth that Nathaniel Dixon Son of Thomas Dixon of Somerset County in the
 Province of Maryland of his free & voluntary will hath put himselfe apprentice to William Round of the same
 County and Province aforesaid learner to learn the science or Trade which he now setteth to be taught and
 with him after the manner of an apprentice to dwell and serve from the eight & twentieth day of July one
 thousand six hundred and ninety unto the full end and Term of seven years from thence next ensuing
 to be fully completed finished and ended. By all which term of seven years the said apprentice the said William
 Round well & truly shall serve his service shall keep Close, his Commandments Lawfull & honest every where he
 shall gladly doe him to his said Master he shall not do or suffer to be done to the value of twelve pence or more by
 the year but shall let if he may or else ^{immediately} his said Master thereof the goods of his said Master he shall not
 meddlesomely waste nor them to any body lend at Dice or any unlawful game he shall not play whereby his
 Master may receive any hurt: fornication in the house of his said Master or else where he shall not commit Ma-
 himoney he shall not contract Taverners he shall not frequent with his own proper goods or any others
 during the said term without the speciall License of his said Master he shall not hire nor hire from the
 service of his said Master day or night he shall not absent or prolong himselfe. but in all things as a good & faithful
 apprentice shall bear & behave himselfe towards his said Master and Mistress and all his during the term
 aforesaid and the said William Round to his said apprentice the science or Art which he now setteth shall teach
 and instruct or cause to be taught and instructed the best way that he may or can in the manner best or navigable
 And also shall find to his said apprentice apparel meat drink washing and Lodging & all other necessaries meet
 and convenient for an apprentice for and during the term aforesaid. Now this Indenture further witnesseth
 that if the said William Round should happen to dye before the expiration of the said term of seven years
 above mentioned it shall & may then be lawful for the said Nathaniel Dixon to be free
