This Indenture made the second day of September in the second year of the reign William & Mary by the grace of god of England Scotland France & Ireland King & Queen defend^r of the faith &c And in the year of our Lord god one thousand six hundred and ninety With witnesseth that where as the R^t honorable Cecilus Lord Baron of Baltimore or Annoq^r Do^m one thousand six hundred sixty seven by his Patent did then grant unto Edward Dikefon of Som^rset County in the Province of Maryland plant^r all that Parcel of Land called Contention lying in the name of the river at the head thereof containing three hundred and nine which viz on the 30th day of June Annoq^r Do^m one thousand six hundred sixty eight the said Edward Dikefon and Elizabeth his wife by their certain deed duly executed & remaining amongst the records in Som^rset County did alienate make over & convey unto Edmund Beauchamp of the County of Somerset and to his heirs & assigns for ever the said three hundred and of land more or less called Contention NOW this indenture further witnesseth Between Edmund Beauchamp and Sarah his wife of the one part And their son Thomas Beauchamp of the other part out of the kindⁿ Love & Care that they the said Edmund and Sarah bequeath unto their Loving son Thomas Beauchamp & especially for and in consideration of one shilling money sterling to them in hand paid before the making & delivery hereof whereof and wherewith the said Edmund & Sarah do acknowledge themselves fully & wholly satisfied Contented & paid & thereof and of every part & parcel hereof John Sully Esq^r and absolutely acquit exonerate & discharge the said Thomas & his heirs for ever have given granted bargained sold enfeoffed & confirmed And do by these presents the said Edm Beauchamp and Sarah his wife freely and absolutely give grant bargain alien sell enfeoff and confirm unto him the said Thomas Beauchamp and to his heirs apart or parcel of the above said Parcel of Land called Contention to the quantity of some hundred acres bounded as followeth beginning at a marked stake in the middle of the branch in the old field commonly called Patrick's field from thence running up the river of Annamstoe to a marked red oak standing close by the main road damme being the lower damme from thence North East to
