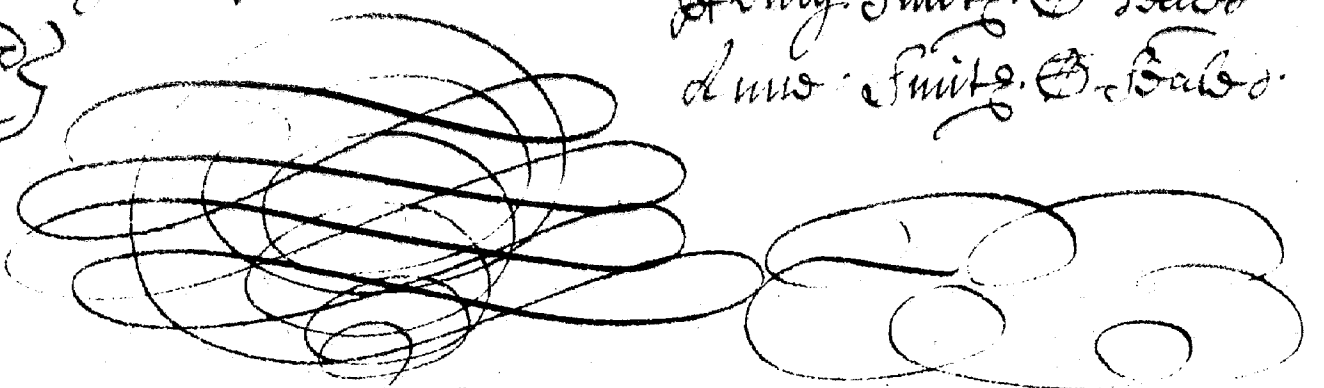

That Indenture made the twentieth day of March in the third year of the Reign of our Sovereign
King James the 2. by the Grace of God. King of England &c. And in the 111. year of the Bond of the
Right Hon^{ble}. Charles, Ober Maryland &c. Anno Domini 1682. Between William: Hearne and Katherine
his wife of Somerset County & Robine of Maryland, Planter, of the one part, and George Russell of the said County
the Robine of the other part WITNESSETH. that whereas the Right Hon^{ble}. Lord Proprietary by his deed of
grant under the great Seal of the said Robine bearing date at St. Maries the first day of June in the 10th
year of his dominion 1685. did grant unto the said Wm: Hearne, a certain tract or portell of Land called
the mounte Situals lying and being on the seaboard side betwixt in the woods from the water, at a Ridge
and between the sea side and Potomack River, beginning at a marked white Oak being a Grove tree of
wood of Land called the Key, thence with a line drawn North east and by East sixly two perches to
marked white Oak being another Grove tree of the said Land called the Key, thence with a line drawn
and by East two hundred forty five perches to a marked forked Red Oak standing on the East side of a marked
tree, thence with a line drawn west two hundred thirty three perches, and from thence with a line drawn
to the first Corner, containing two hundred acres more or less, together with all the right profits, benefits
privileges thereunto belonging Royall mines excepted. to have and to hold the same, unto him the said
William: Hearne his Heirs and assigns for ever more sure heirs, robustants. For which profits and
the said grant is mentioned and expressed, returns being thereunto had, it doth more fully and more
appear, Now know ye that the said William: Hearne, and Katherine my wife, for divers good causes and
considerations we thereunto moving, but more especially and particularly for and in Consideration of
ten thousand five hundred pounds to us in hand paid by George Russell a forsooth, the whole whereof
by these presents at New to go and that hereby we are fully satisfied contented and paid to the
of every part & parcel thereof, we the said Wm: Hearne and Katherine do hereby acquit, release
discharge, the said George Russell his Heirs and assigns for ever, have given granted
sole and full power confirmed and by these presents to give grant bargain alien
