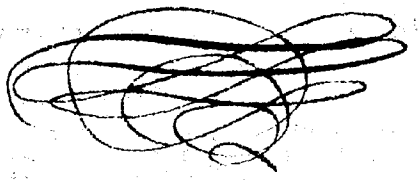
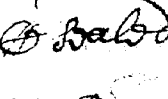

Congleton & James: Castiel Juniors of County in the County of Maryland Gent<sup>ms</sup> are bounden unto their Ma<sup>ties</sup> King William and Queen Mary in the full sum of Two hundred thousand pounds of good sound Merchants livers and paid to their Ma<sup>ties</sup> King William and Queen Mary or to their heirs, to the whole payment well and truly made we bind us, and sure of us by him self and for the whole firmly by these presents, In testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this 11<sup>th</sup> day of November in the second year of their Ma<sup>ties</sup> Reign Over England &c. and in the year of our Lord God One thousand six hundred and eighty.

**THE CONDITION** of this Obligation is such that if the above bound Stephen Luffe do well and truly serve their Ma<sup>ties</sup> their Heirs and heirs in the Office of High Sheriff of Somerset County and shall render unto their said Ma<sup>ties</sup> and other their Ma<sup>ties</sup> Officers, a true faith full and perfect acc<sup>t</sup>. of all and singular their Ma<sup>ties</sup> Rents and other fees, and dues that he shall be intrusted with by their said Ma<sup>ties</sup> or any of their Officers within that County, to receive and collect, and his acc<sup>t</sup>. to their said Ma<sup>ties</sup> Heirs and heirs for his Rents and fines, for foreward or other dues belonging to their Ma<sup>ties</sup>, And also to account of all fees, dues or sums of money for labors or fees due to any of their Ma<sup>ties</sup> Officers within that County shall pass and give an account of, at the City of St. Maries in the County aforesaid in his own proper person by the first Tuesday in April next ensuing the date hereof and in all other things as Sheriff of the said County shall be bound himself, well and honestly as well towards their said Ma<sup>ties</sup> as to all other persons that touch. Then this Obligation to be void and of no force or effect to remain in full force and virtue

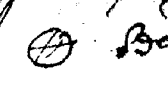

In testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this 9<sup>th</sup> day of November in the second year of their Ma<sup>ties</sup> Reign Over England &c. and in the year of our Lord God One thousand six hundred and eighty.

**THE CONDITION** of this Obligation is such that if the above bound Robert Nearn, do well and truly serve their Ma<sup>ties</sup> their Heirs and heirs as a Naval Officer of their Ma<sup>ties</sup> dues for that County of Somerset and shall render unto their said Ma<sup>ties</sup> and other their Ma<sup>ties</sup> Officers, a true faith full and perfect account, of all and singular the sum<sup>s</sup> and sums of money which shall be by him collected or received from any Master or Masters of ships or owned, Merchants, Ma<sup>ties</sup>, or any other Officer or Officers of any ships or shippes, to his or his assigns, that then this Obligation to be void and of no force or effect to remain in full force and virtue.
