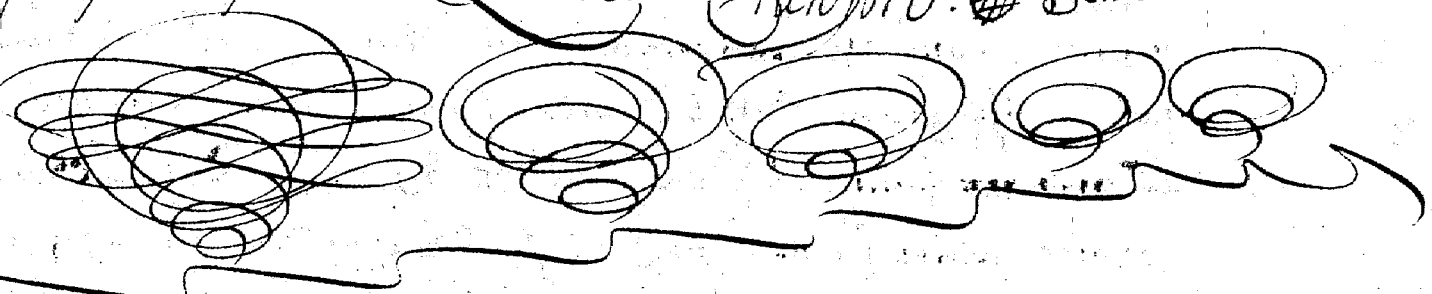


THESE PRESENTS

And one two year old mare adun bay some of the same mare, also one yearling horse some of the same mare to have and to hold the said Walter with all their mares in warranty from the claim of any person or persons whatsoever pretending or to pretend any claim unto any of the said Walter mare or horse and all being already collated for the consideration of two thousand three hundred pounds of tobacco in witness my hand and seal April 21. Year 1690.

This Indenture made the thirteenth day of January in the second year of their Ma^{ties} Reigne William and Mary by the grace of God of England Scotland France & Ireland King & Queene defend. of y^e faith or and in the year of our Lord God one Thousand six hundred and ninety Betweene John Dorman of Somerset County in the Province of Maryland plant^r and Sarah his wife of the one part and John West of the same County and Province of the other party Witnesseth That the said John Dorman & Sarah his wife for and in consideration of three thousand pounds of tobacco to them in hand paid by the said John West before the enfealing and delivery hereof the receipt whereof they doe hereby acknowledge accordingly and themselves there with fully satisfied have granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed & confirmed And by these presents doe fully clearly & absolutely grant bargain sell enfeoff and confirm unto the aboves^d John West and to his heirs for ever all that tract parcell of land called Beech and line situate lying & being in Somerset County on the east side of Chesapeake Bay about two miles from the South side of Back Creek in Manokin at the head of Phillip Berrys and Nicholas Mountains Land bounded as followeth beginning at a marked Beech standing by the Road w^{ch} goeth from the head of Back Creek to y^e North side of Anemessip River thence with a line drawn South east two hundred & forty perches to a marked white oak thence with a line drawn South west fifty seven perches to a red oak thence with a line drawn North west two hundred & forty perches thence with a line drawn to the first boulder continuing & now laid out for one hundred acres of land more or less according to the certificate ~~Survey~~ of Survey hereof taken & returned into the Land office at S^t Marys bearing date the third day of November one thousand six hundred eighty five and then remaining upon record w^{ch} said one hundred acres of Land and all & every the wayes profits commodities & appurtenances whatsoever to the said Land belonging or in any wise appertaining and all Deeds Patents writings & Evidences whatsoever belonging to the said one hundred acres of Land called Beech & line And have cued to hold the said Land & premises with the appurtenances herein or hereby mentioned or intended to be granted bargained & sold unto the said John West his heirs & assigns for ever and to the only proper use and behoofe of the abovesaid John West his heirs and assigns for ever And the said John Dorman for himselfe his heirs executors & adm^{rs} and for the said Sarah his
