 testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this seventeenth day of October in the
 third year of their Majesties reign Anno Domini 1691.

THE CONDITION of this Obligation is such that if the above bounden Robert King, do well &
 truly observe and satisfy the last will and Testament of Jan. Galbraith deceased, which will beareth date
 the twelfth day of August One thousand six hundred ninety and one, as well as to pay all and every the
 debts upon Order had and Obtained from their Majesties Justices of Peace in Court sitting so far forth as the
 said Estate will & come or the Law require, And well and truly to observe the several Causes mentioned to you
 in Letters of Administration to you granted the 8. day of September Anno Domini 1691. And also to keep heretofore
 and hereafter the Justices of the Peace of Somerset County for probat of Wills, and granting Administrations
 and all other Officers therein authorized, that this Obligation be void and of none effect, Otherways to
 be and remain in full power fort and valid.
