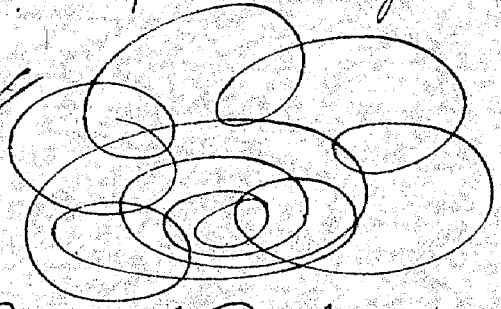


John: Newton Esq of Accomack

and whereupon the said John: Newton by Edward Jones his attorney
com^{es} and says that the said James: Maynard upon the second day of May in the year of o^{ur} L^{ord}s 1693. then com^{ing}
into the said John: Newton in the sum & quantity of twelve hundred pounds of tobacco as appears by a certain
Writting under the hand & seal said James Maynard then in Court produced, where said sum of 1200. pounds of tobacco.
the said James hath not paid in his life time nor Hannah the w^{id} of the said James hath not paid since his
decease, but doth refuse to pay y^e aforesaid sum of 1200. pounds of tobacco although often lawfully required, whereupon
the p^{re}sent bill is returned and hath left to the value of 2000 pounds of tobacco thereupon being his debt
of Lrd. Edward Jones.

Know all men by these presents that I James: Maynard of the County of Somerset Province of Maryland Jun^r holden
am bound & stand justly indebted unto John: Newton of Accomack y^e just sum & quantity of twelve hundred pounds of good
sound Merchantable tobacco & Cask for the true & perform^{ance} whereof I bound me my Heirs Executors & assigns to pay or cause to be paid
the aforesaid quantity of tobacco unto y^e aforesaid John: Newton him his Heirs Executors & assigns at or upon the last day of
October next ensuing the date hereof at Snow Hill Landing or at some convenient Landing upon Pocomoke River at
home for a valuable Consideration in hand allready rec^d. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this second
day of May 1693.

Debts of Alexander Delahoe. do^{es} was summoned to answer unto John: Delahoe of Accomack
of a plea that they render unto him the full & just sum of four hundred & sixty pounds of
Merchantable leaf tobacco & Cask. And whereupon the said John: Delahoe by Robert Dent his
Attorney complains that whereas the said Alexander in his life time viz y^e 28th day of May in the year of our L^{ord}s 1684. at
Mentem with in the Jurisdiction of this Court by his certain Bill obligatorij where the said John: Delahoe took of y^e said
Alexander signed & made to be into Court the date whereof is the day & year aforesaid & bound himself to be indebted
in his life time to the said John: Delahoe in the full & just sum of four hundred & sixty pounds of tobacco to be paid to y^e
said John: Delahoe in Accomack County on y^e day & at or upon y^e 10th day of October next ensuing y^e date of
said Bill, to whose payment the said Alexander bound himself firmly by the said Bill & he hath by the said Alex^r in his life
