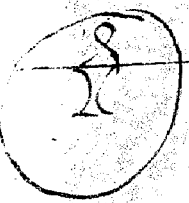


Wherefore formerly obtained judgment against Eskeam Wilson for a default committed by him to

 and two pounds of tobacco. Eskeam Wilson of this he do hereby acknowledge to have received from the
 said Eskeam Wilson full payment or satisfaction for the said judgment as also three hundred
 ninety pounds of tobacco for evidence due in Court proved since the Bill of Exchange for the
 same was my hand this 7th day of May 1697.

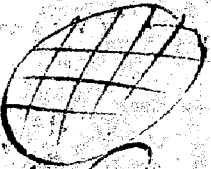

Whereas to His Majesty it doth concern that the three ~~plains~~ working day
 of September 1697 came before us, the Chief Officer of Their Majesties Customs in
 Port of Newmar William Loggal master or Commander of the ship or Vessel
 called the Swift Indebtor burden eight Tons or thereabouts mounted with
 guns, navigated with twelve men and boys English built, and produced a Certificate
 and made oath that at Virg. he became bound unto the Majesty up on or a Court
 the 15th day of June last with Certificate that also such Sug. 100^{lb} Cotton Wool
 Indigo Indico, Ginger, Fustick, or other dying Wood, of the growth, production
 or manufacture of any English Plantation in America, Asia, or
 Africa, as should be Laden on board the said ship or Vessel at any of the said
 English Plantations, should be brought to some Port of England, Wales or
 Town of Berwick upon Tweed, and be there unloaded and put on shore, the
 danger of the loss only excepted, and it is hereby further certified, that there
 have been discharge and landed one of the said ship or Vessel within the
 Port of Newmar one hundred and ten hogheads of Tob in Cask, and twenty
 of tobacco in bulk for which his Majesty's duties have been levied and paid
 paid, dated at the Customs House in the County of Oxford in the ninth
 year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord William King of England the annuity
 Day 1697
