

Wherefore and the said Margarett did acknowledge her self to be indebted to their Maties King William & Queen Mary the sum of twenty pounds sterling money of England, the said Jonathan: Towors & Edward: Wheeler in the sum of ten pounds a piece like money aforesaid, all due to be paid on their goods & Chables lands & Tenements for their Maties use & fra. The Condition of whose Recognizance is such that if the above bound Margarett be of the good behaviour and abstinence to all their Maties Loyal people of this Province during this Courts pleasure, and also pay her food: expended, and that she leave Daniel: Donnaher: Plantation after she has finished her Crops now in hand, then the above Recognizance to be void and of none effect otherway to be and remain in full power force & virtue.

Whereas Daniel: Donnaher: s Wife was summoned in y matter betwixt the aforesd Margarett: Gallaway & Tho: Quillman and that it was made apparant to y Justice in Court sitting that the sd Daniel would not suffer his said Wife to attend the Court. It was therefore ordered the said Daniel to finde for Contempt, for hindring his Wife to give her Evidence & fra. Ordered his wife the said Daniel give security for his good behaviour & fra. to be in custody till given Whereupon came the said Daniel Donnaher with his two servants (viz) Robert: Catlin & John: Harris and the sd Daniel did acknowledge himself to owe & be indebted to their Maties King William & Queen Mary the sum of twenty pounds sterling money of England and the said Catlin & Harris in the sum of ten pounds a piece like money aforesaid, all due to be paid on their goods & Chables lands & Tenements for their Maties use & fra.

The Condition of whose Recognizance is such that if the above bound Daniel: Donnaher be of the good behaviour and abstinence to all their Maties Loyal people of this Province during this Courts pleasure, and that he the sd Daniel do put or cause to be put away or dismist the aforesd Margarett: Gallaway from of his Land (viz) the Plantation where now y sd Margarett lieth after she have finished her Crops now in hand, that he shall not be seen privately in y sd Margarett's Company and also pay her food: then this Recognizance to be void & of none effect otherway to be and remain in force & fra.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that if the said Mary doth on the second Tuesday in August next ensuing the date hereof make her appearance before their Maties Justices of the Peace, and then y there answer unto what shall be objected against her by their Maties Court of the present in an impeachment of fornication and abide the award thereof y then the above Recognizance to be void and none effect, otherway to be stand in full force & virtue as Witness my hand & seal this 24. of July 1693
