Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal Section 2, of Article 7, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Carroll County," sub-title "Alms House," and to amend and re-enact the same.

Which was read the first time.

Senate bill entitled an Act to provide for the payment of the salary due the Secretary of the State Board of Health for the year ending December 31st, 1877,

Was considered and ordered to be printed.

Senate bill entitled an Act to provide for the further extension of the charter of the Frederick Town Savings Institution, supplementary to an Act passed at January Session, 1858, Chapter 162, entitled a "further supplement to an Act to incorporate the Frederick Town Savings Institution passed at December Session, 1826, March 9, 1827, Chapter 189," repealing the first Section thereof and re-enacting the same with amendments.
