- (c) Any violation of the provisions of this sub-title shall be deemed a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be subject to a fine of not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), and each day that said violation shall continue shall be deemed a separate violation provided, however, that the provisions of this section shall not apply to the City of Baltimore.
- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1947.

## CHAPTER 917.

## (House Bill 738)

AN ACT to repeal Section 260 of Article 56 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Licenses", sub-title "Gasoline Tax", said section relating to reciprocal agreements with the District of Columbia as to certain licenses.

Whereas, this section has been superseded by the later laws relating to motor vehicles and is therefore no longer necessary; therefore

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 260 of Article 56 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Licenses", sub-title "Gasoline Tax", be and it is hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1947.

## CHAPTER 918.

## (House Bill 755)

AN ACT to add two new sections to Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Charles County", sub-title "Schools", said new sections to be known as Sections 241A and 241B, and to follow imme-
