

Chapter 362.

AN ACT to refund to Charles S. Morgan and Alcinda M. Robinson, executors of the last will of George W. Robinson, deceased, certain moneys erroneously paid by them into the State treasury.

Directed to
pay.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Treasurer, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, is hereby authorized and directed to pay to Charles S. Morgan and Alcinda M. Robinson, executors of the last will of Geo. W. Robinson, deceased, or their order, the sum of three hundred and twenty-two dollars and seventy-eight cents, paid by them in error, it appearing that said erroneous payment was made by them for tax on executors' commissions to which they were not entitled; and the said repayment being recommended by the officers of the treasury department.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 363.

AN ACT to Incorporate the Maryland Steam and Hydraulic Power Company.

Created a corporation.

Sue and be
sued.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Alfred D. Miller, J. W. S. Brady, Enoch Pratt, J. Q. A. Holloway, F. F. Pope and all such other persons as shall associate with them, by becoming stockholders in the manner hereinafter provided, are created a corporation and body politic, to be styled and known by the name of "The Maryland Steam and Hydraulic Power Company," and by that name shall have perpetual succession, and shall be able and capable in law to sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, answer and be answered, unto and in any court of law or equity, and to make and use a common seal, and the same to change and alter at pleasure, and establish such
