Who to sell
and convey.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the County Commissioners of Harford county be and they are hereby empowered and authorized in their discretion to sell and convey to said trustees all the right, title and interest of said county in and to said lot of ground described in section first of this act.

Vacancy—
how filled.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That the said trustees or survivors or survivor of them may fill any vacancy that may occur by death, resignation or removal from the county of any member of this corporation, and that said trustees, by their corporate name as aforesaid, may sue and be sued, contract and make by laws for their government and action, and take and convey property for the purpose aforesaid.

Effective.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 367.

AN ACT to add an additional section to chapter one hundred and fifty-nine of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An act to repeal chapter two hundred and twenty of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-six," entitled "An act to establish a free bridge over the Patapsco river," at or near the present site of Light Street Bridge, and to provide for free travel from Anne Arundel county to Baltimore city, and to prohibit fast driving over and across the draw of Light Street Bridge, &c.
