

Chapter 390.

AN ACT to repeal chapter one hundred and twenty-seven of the acts passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and eighty, entitled "An act to repeal section sixteen of article thirty-eight, Code of Public General Laws," so far as the same relates to Dorchester county, and to add an additional section to article ten, Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Dorchester county," sub-title "Crier," and to re-enact the same with amendments so as to read as follows:

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That chapter one hundred and twenty-seven of the acts passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and eighty, entitled "An act to repeal section sixteen of article thirty-eight, Code of Public General Laws," so far as the same relates to Dorchester county, and to add an additional section to article ten, Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Dorchester county," sub-title "Crier," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows:

SECTION ... The crier of the Circuit Court for Dorchester county shall be entitled to and receive a per diem of three dollars for each and every day he shall be employed as such, which shall be in full and in lieu of all other allowances now authorized by law; and the commissioners of Dorchester county are authorized and directed, at their next meeting for laying the county levy, and annually thereafter, to levy for the use of the crier of said court, on the assessable property of said county, such sum or sums of money as they shall deem sufficient to pay the per diem of the crier of said court for both the general and equity terms thereof; and upon presentation to said county commissioners of the certificates of the clerk of said court certifying the number of days in which he has been engaged at each term of said court, the
