

whenever he may see proper; and said commissioners shall, before the first day of May, in each and every year, by one insertion published in one or more newspapers printed in Cecil county, a statement of the receipts and expenditures of said town for such year.

Publish statement.

SEC. 25. *And be it enacted*, That the County Commissioners of Cecil county may, at discretion, levy annually upon the assessable property of the county, and pay over to the said president and commissioners such sum as they may see fit, to aid in keeping the streets of said town, as part of the public roads of the county, in good repair.

Levy annually

SEC. 26. *And be it enacted*, That if the inhabitants of said town at any time neglect to make an election as herein directed, the power of electing commissioners shall not thereupon cease, but shall continue as though such election had been made, and the president and commissioners for the time being shall remain in office until such annual election shall be held.

Failure to elect.

SEC. 27. *And be it enacted*, That the inhabitants of said town, at the annual election for commissioners each and every year, shall have the right to vote on the question of license for or against the sale of intoxicating liquors in said town.

Question of license.

SEC. 28. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage, but it shall not be necessary that this act shall be published as prescribed by the provisions of the second section of chapter thirty-one of the acts of Assembly of the year eighteen hundred and sixty-five, relating to the publication of Public Local Laws.
