

Chapter 414.

AN ACT for the payment of a sum of money to Martin Gallion and Sister, of Harford county, Maryland, for cattle destroyed under chapter 439, acts 1880, Public Laws of Maryland, title "Pleuro Pneumonia."

Draw warrant.

SECTION 1. *And be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Comptroller of the State, be and he is hereby instructed to draw his warrant on the Treasurer of the State for the sum of sixty dollars, in compensation to him, the said Martin Gallion, and sister, in full for all claims for cattle destroyed and loss sustained thereby, under chapter 439 of the acts of 1880.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That this act take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 415.

AN ACT to compel any person or persons, firm or firms in Garrett county, who are now or may hereafter be engaged in, or wish to carry on Livery, Sale and Hiring business, to take out a license from the clerk of the Circuit Court of Garrett county.

SECTION 1. *And be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That any person or persons, firm or firms in Garrett county, who are now or may hereafter be engaged in, or wish to carry on the livery, sale and hiring business, to take out a license from the clerk of the Circuit Court of Garrett county, and the amount of said license to be twenty dollars, and by him, the said clerk of the Circuit Court, to be paid over to the county commissioners of the above-named county, and by them applied to the public roads of Garrett county, the said clerk to
