11 DR. LOEVY: In other words, the towns there will
12 have all powers except what are denied by statute.

13 DEAN FORDHAM: You might like to see this.

14 DR. LOEVY: They classify them, though. This
15 is again with classification.

16 DEAN FORDHAM: I would have to take a look to
17 be sure.

18 THE CHAIRMAN: Classification is provided for
19 in the Kentucky provision also, but without any definition
20 of what they mean by classification. It just says the
21 General Assembly may classify.
