

1 JUDGE WARNKEN: As far as I am concerned, it
2 is quite agreeable to me. I would like to call things
3 by their real name.

4 JUDGE BRUNE: How about just Court of Sessions?

5 MR. ENEY: I think that is what Judge Fairbanks
6 suggested.

7 JUDGE FAIRBANKS: That is right.

8 THE CHAIRMAN: Does anyone have any comments
9 on Subsection (b), of Section 4? This, I believe, carries
10 out the great majority of the opinions of the State
11 Bar Committee, which is working with us on this article.

12 JUDGE RASIN: Is there any provision in here
13 as to election of Circuit Court judges, as to whether
14 they would be elected from individual counties?

15 MR. MARTINEAU: It is provided they be elected
16 from the individual county.

17 THE CHAIRMAN: That comes a little later, Judge
18 Rasin.

19 JUDGE RASIN: I will save my comment for that.
