CHAPTER 15.

AN ACT enabling the Locust Point Company of the city of Baltimore, to fill up and close a dock upon its property, lying to the east of the ground and premises now occupied by Henry A. Ramsay, in the city of Baltimore.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Locust Point Company of Baltimore city, be and it is hereby authorized and empowered to fill up, close and wharf over, the mouth of a dock one hundred feet wide, situate upon its property on the south side of the harbor of Baltimore city; said dock being situate about one hundred and twenty-seven feet, more or less, easterly from the easternmost line of the land now occupied by Henry A. Ramsay.
