

and eighty-four cents, being the amount erroneously collected and paid into the State Treasury for taxes on commissions to guardians, the passage of this bill having been recommended by the officers of the Treasury Department of this State.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 325.

AN ACT to add an additional section to article two of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Washington County," sub-title "County Commissioners," to be called section eighty-seven.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That an additional section be added to the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Washington county," sub-title "County Commissioners," to read as follows :

Additional section.

SECTION 87. The County Commissioners are authorized and empowered to offer a reward for the arrest and conviction of criminals for offences committed within said county whenever in their judgment the nature and character of the offence will warrant it, and to levy upon the assessed property of the county to pay the same; provided, however, that the reward to be paid in any one case shall not exceed one hundred dollars.
