

CHAPTER 344.

AN ACT to authorize and direct the Board of County Commissioners of Baltimore county to levy a sum of money for the building of a School House at Rayville, in the Sixth Election District of Baltimore county.

Public School.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Board of County Commissioners of Baltimore county are hereby authorized and directed to levy on the assessable property of said county, at the next annual levy after the passage of this act, for the sum of one thousand dollars, for the purpose of building a School House at Rayville, in the Sixth Election District of said county, and said sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall then be applied by and for that purpose paid to the Board of School Commissioners of said county, for the erection of a public school house, at the before named location; the said building to cost not exceeding the sum of fifteen hundred dollars.

CHAPTER 345.

AN ACT to make all plaintiffs in civil suits in Caroline county, where suits are brought before a Justice of the Peace, to bring said suits in the Election Districts where the defendant resides.

Justices' jurisdiction.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That all plaintiffs in civil suits in Caroline county, when suits are brought before a Justice of the Peace, shall bring said suit in the Election District where the defendant resides.
