

1 MR. CASE: That is right, but my point is
2 certainly the lawyers of the State voting on this very
3 subject on several different occasions have all come
4 to the conclusion each time, and in the case of Court of
5 Special Appeals, it was a unanimous opinion that this
6 Section at least as far as judges is concerned is not
7 needed, and it would be no abuse. Now, as to whether
8 there would be abuse in minor offices or not, I don't
9 know, but I do know as far as the Judiciary is concerned,
10 the present modern thinking of people is that it is not
11 necessary. I just think we ought to rethink this whole
12 thing, and see whether it is or isn't necessary.

13 DR. BARD: I would like to read from the
14 Constitution if I might, Section 6 of Article 1, United
15 States Constitution, Page 115.

16 No senator or representative shall during the
17 time for which he was elected be appointed to any civil
18 office under authority of the United States which shall
19 have been created or the emoluments thereof shall have
20 been increased during such time.
