2 DR. BARD: How would you word it?

3 MRS. BOTHE: I would make the three days run
4 from the time the bill is printed.

5 THE CHAIRMAN: I suggest to you if you do this
6 or the existing change, you are preventing a one-day
7 special session.

8 MR. CASE: Plus the fact in many cases, the
9 bills are printed long before the session even opens.

10 MRS. BOTHE: That is all right. It is just
11 a question of having a bill.

12 MR. CASE: That accomplishes just what you
13 seek to avoid.

14 MRS. BOTHE: I am not trying to create a wait-
15 ing period, but just some opportunity for interested
16 people to read the bill in black and white, and under
17 this provision, it could come out now or before it is
18 passed, or even ten minutes.
