2 MR. CASE: My point is that under that system,
3 the bill could have been printed five days before the
4 session began which often happens, and you could bring
5 it down and pass it within three minutes after it was
6 introduced.

7 MRS. BOTHE: That is right.

8 MR. CASE: I think that is wrong.

9 MR. CLAGETT: Mr. Chairman, actually if the
10 members who are required to give a final vote have not
11 had a chance to acquaint themselves, they can always
12 raise the point before the vote is taken; so it says
13 here, no final vote for passage shall be taken, so
14 aren't we really debating over something that isn't
15 necessary?

16 MR. SCANLAN: Mr. Chairman, I wasn't at the
17 meeting of the Legislative Committee. I was on vacation,
18 and I am not a slave to the model, but the model accom-
19 modates your point and at the same time allays Dick's
20 fears that the bill would have to lay on the desk of the
21 members for five days.
