9 MR. BOND: Dr. Bard left out the language,
10 in final form.

11 DR. BARD: I left it out because I felt that
12 could be confusing.

13 MR. BOND: Does this mean the bill can lie on
14 the desk and be amended and be passed immediately?

15 THE CHAIRMAN: Yes. Any further question?

16 DR. BARD: When it is in final form?

17 THE CHAIRMAN: Section 18.

18 DR. BARD: The style of all laws of this
19 State shall be, "Be it enacted by the General Assembly
20 of Maryland": and the General Assembly shall enact no
21 law except by bill; and every law enacted by the General
