

1 Assembly shall embrace but one subject, and that shall
2 be described in its title; and no law, nor section of
3 law, shall be revived, or amended by reference to its
4 title, or section only; nor shall any law be construed by
5 reason of its title, to grant powers, or confer rights
6 which are not expressly contained in the body of the
7 act; and it shall be the duty of the General Assembly, in
8 amending any article, or section of the code of laws of
9 this State, to enact the same, as the said article, or
10 section would read when amended.

12 I would like to ask a question. What is the purpose
13 or the necessity for the second phrase, and the General
14 Assembly shall enact no law except by bill?

15 MR. MINDEL: I think a question of resolution
16 or bill.

18 does it make if they call it a resolution or bill?

19 MR. MILLER: A resolution can only be in one
20 House. A joint resolution has to pass both.
