11 We had it recently in Montgomery County, which is not a
12 State; the County Council attempted to redistrict by
13 resolution when they could no longer act under their
14 legislative powers, and there was considerable discussion
15 in the trial court as to what they had done and it was
16 perfectly clear they had acted by resolution in the
17 situation where they could only act by ordinance, and I
18 don't have the research even in my head, but there are
19 some problems about this in other States.
