

1 THE CHAIRMAN: You wouldn't want it both places
2 would you?

3 PROFESSOR ASPER: I feel this way, that we
4 thought that it belonged here in Section 4, but we would
5 hate to include in the Declaration of Rights all the
6 materials presently found in the legislative article, with
7 specific reference to the State Roads Commission and
8 things of that character.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: That is why I had asked Mr.
10 Gentry the question I did whether the Committee intended
11 this provision in Section 4 to supersede Section 40,
12 for instance, of Article 3. I take it you are expressing
13 some reservations about this.

14 MR. GENTRY: I didn't understand it in that
15 sense. Our last sentence here really was not in the
16 first drafts and came out of an effort to stick as far
17 as possible with the United States Bill of Rights
18 language, and of course, that sentence verbatim is a copy
19 of that. It is just that we feel that that is all that is
20 warranted in a bill of rights, and if any more detailed
21 expression is to be found, it should be somewhere else,
