2 THE CHAIRMAN: Was the matter discussed at all
3 with the Committee on Legislative Department?

4 MR. GENTRY: No.

5 THE CHAIRMAN: Dr. Jenkins?

6 DR. JENKINS: At a previous meeting of the
7 Commission, I had stated that I thought that the State
8 Constitution in Maryland should have a strong provision
9 for protecting the rights of people, rights not be denied
10 because of religion, race or color, and I was particularly
11 speaking of race or color.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: Dr. Jenkins, may I interrupt
13 you a moment? I thought you were going to speak on this
14 matter of domain. Do you mind if we leave this a moment
15 because I don't want to leave that hanging? It seems to me
16 this ought not be lost sight of, and therefore, I will
17 ask Mr. Brooks to advise Dr. Bard, who can't be here
18 this morning, and it was suggested Dr. Bard and Mr. Gentry
19 consult about this and either report back to the Commission
20 the definite recommendation that it be excluded from
21 Article 3 of the Constitution or not excluded. Can we
