To answer Judge Adkins' question, Dr. Bard, can you mention any others besides those you did mention, impeachment?

DR. BARD: Expulsion of members, two-thirds; and amendments to the Constitution is three-fifths, and I don't know, Dr. Jenkins, you could make a pretty good debate as to whether an amendment to the Constitution is less important than, let us say the elimination of three readings.

Actually it would be pretty difficult to set up a good debate in that connection. My own feeling is that Judge Adkins has a poin. I believe it would be important for us to enumerate all instances in this connection.

THE CHAIRMAN: In order to make some progress today, let me say that we will put up to vote the separate vote on each, the four or five instances that have been mentioned in discussion, so that we can see what we are dealing with.

DR. BARD: These three or four, the three readings, expulsion of members, amendments to the Consti-
