3 applied here is the ingenuity we've been talking about in
4 other areas.

5 MR. HOFF: Perhaps, then, this should be limited
6 to population rather than to open up this Pandora's Box of
7 classifications.

8 MR. CLAGETT: That is exactly what we debated
9 for a long period of time and came up with an attempt to
10 carry out the basic purpose of giving the General Assembly
11 a free range of action and yet giving some formula, and
12 appropriate is the word I underlined insofar as the Pandora
13 Box idea.
