2 JUDGE ADKINS: Yes, sir.

3 MR. MILLER: There is just one weakness
4 in the way this is framed. It seems to me if we are
5 going to have a bicameral General Assembly or Legislature,
6 it seems to me that the person who makes the call for
7 this special session should be designated either the
8 President of the Senate or somebody. If you have two
9 houses, both or either, there ought to be one central
10 officer who is responsible for calling that convention
11 after the written request comes in.

12 JUDGE ADKINS: We have provided, Ted, I
13 thought we had answered that by saying shall be
14 convened by the presiding officers of both houses.

15 MR. MILLER: Suppose one house says we
16 are going to meet next Tuesday and the other one says
17 next Thursday. I think it ought to be, the actual
18 call ought to go out from one particular person.
