2 MR. SAYRE: That we cannot in this way even con-
3 sider a regional government, really, until we've got a
4 region?

5 THE CHAIRMAN: That's the whole point.

6 MR. SAYRE: Then I have another problem, about
7 those five per cent voting for Governor, are we talking
8 about five per cent of the entire State? The way I see it
9 here, that's the way it would work out, because what region
10 are we talking about?

11 MR. CLAGETT: I think the language is clear, Mr.
12 Chairman.

13 MR. SAYRE: The language with the region isn't
14 clear, the way I see it.

15 MR. CASE: Residents of the proposed region.

16 MR. SAYRE: You are talking about the proposed
17 region, number one. Then you are talking about five per
18 cent of those voting for Governor. Maybe I'm wrong, but
19 it seems a little loose.

20 THE CHAIRMAN: I think the whole phrase needs
21 tightening up. I assume you don't mean bearing the names
