2 THE CHAIRMAN: Would you accept that, Mr. Sayre?

3 MR. SAYRE: Yes.

4 MRS. FREEDLANDER: Mr. Chairman, will we not
5 have to change 11.01(b), then, because some of this will be
6 repetitious?

7 THE CHAIRMAN: No. I take it that 11.01(b) is
8 intended to express the notion that notwithstanding local
9 home rule for counties, regions and so forth, the Legislature
10 nevertheless retains the power to abolish them or to alter
11 them and so forth.

12 MRS. FREEDLANDER: And multi-county civil divi-
13 sions are in that, too.

14 THE CHAIRMAN: That's right.

15 MR. CLAGETT: By that degree of repetition, you
16 are including the petition process which you wouldn't other-
17 wise have in the other two.

18 THE CHAIRMAN: Right. Mr. Haile?

19 MR. HAILE: Mr. Chairman, are we considering
20 now amendments to the alternative sections?

21 THE CHAIRMAN: Yes.
