3 that he was in any way misrepresented, that somebody,
4 maybe Mr. Brooks, read the memorandum to the Commission.
5 It is not very long.

7 every member of the Commission, Mr. Case.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: All right.

10 JUDGE ADKINS: It was not? I thought it had
11 been.

12 MR. BROOKS: Do you want it read?

13 THE CHAIRMAN: Do you want to read it, Judge
14 Adkins, or do you want Mr. Brooks to?

15 MR. CASE: I think it should be read.

16 JUDGE ADKINS: Well, I will be glad to read it.

17 "The Office of Comptroller of the Treasury was
18 originally created by the Constitution of 1851 (Article 6,
19 Section 1). The Comptroller is now chosen by the qualified
20 electors of the State for a term of four years. The
21 Comptroller and the Treasurer constitute the Treasury
