

1 point of trying to write into the Constitution what the
2 number ought to be. I think that should be left up to
3 the Legislature.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Bond?

5 MR. BOND: I disagree with Mr. Martineau to
6 the extent that I don't see how when you can let the
7 Legislature be the judge of what percentage of the
8 voters shall judge the Legislature's act. This doesn't
9 make sense to me. I would agree with him that three
10 per cent is much too low, and to get the matter on the
11 floor, I would propose, six per cent and see what happens.

12 MR. HOFF: Second the motion.

13 DR. BURDETTE: I want to introduce a Nebraska
14 idea. The point was made that this may be a minority
15 in the small part of the State. In the Nebraska
16 constitution we used to have a clause it would be
17 comparable here to three or six per cent, including
18 three per cent or it could be a different one in at
19 least two-fifths of the county. That meant that it had
20 to be a general state sentiment.
