

1 MR. MILLER: Do I understand -- a parlia-
2 mentary inquiry -- do I understand as recommended that
3 one and a half per cent of the voters could block any
4 law for 30 days.

5 THE CHAIRMAN: No, not if it was passed
6 by three-fifths vote.

7 MR. MILLER: But they could block any other
8 law, one and a half per cent.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: Yes.

10 MR. CASE: Under his motion three per cent.

11 MR. MILLER: I said under three.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: Yes.

13 MR. DELIA: Mr. Chairman, I would speak
14 against raising the percentage factor in the referendum
15 for the simple reason I spoke before, that you only have
16 about 30 days after the Legislature adjourns in order
17 to get your petitions in. You have to have a pretty
18 highly organized group of people who are concerned about
19 an issue in order to get those 23,000 names involved in
20 this particular instance, because this is how many votes
21 you used in the last Gubernatorial campaign. It is very
