

1 MR. SAYRE: Not more than.

2 THE CHAIRMAN: I am sorry, not more than
3 10 per cent, raise their hands. Opposed. The motion
4 is lost, 4 to 18.

5 Mr. Sayre?

6 MR. SAYRE: Another alternative I would
7 like to suggest, in the form of a motion, that it be 10
8 per cent of the number of voters of the successful
9 Gubernatorial candidate in the last general election,
10 a third of which shall not be more in any one political
11 subdivision.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: Is there a second?

13 MR. CASE: If we get six per cent, how do
14 we pass ten?

15 THE CHAIRMAN: He is on a different base.

16 MR. SAYRE: Ten per cent of the number of
17 votes passed for the successful Gubernatorial candidate
18 in the last general election.

19 THE CHAIRMAN: Is there a second? It fails
20 for lack of a second.
