

1 Legislature to undertake this mandatory review, and if
2 we are going to have it review its own salaries commencing
3 with 1970, I don't see why this wouldn't work.

4 DR. BARD: Would it not be true that you could
5 really have this review by statutory law without putting
6 it in the Constitution?

7 MR. SAYRE: You could.

8 DR. BARD: Why put it in?

9 MR. SAYRE: How do you know you will? In other
10 words, I am a little bit scared of getting in arrears as
11 much as we are right now on proper compensation, and if
12 we had mandatory review of compensation at least once every
13 ten years, I think we would have a little more control
14 with realistic income.

15 THE CHAIRMAN: Don't the natural pressures of
16 the people who are underpaid take care of that?

17 MR. SAYRE: It hasn't to date, has it?

18 THE CHAIRMAN: That is because they have been
19 fixed in the Constitution, but if the Legislature has
20 the control over these salaries as we have recommended,
21 wouldn't the natural pressures be sufficient to take care
