12 your hands, do you want to do that, or do you want to leave
13 it to the Committee on Style?

14 DR. BARD: I think I would like the privilege
15 of putting it in.

16 THE CHAIRMAN: Do you want to take up each of
17 the questions separately, then, first being the residence
18 in the State for one year?

19 MR. MILES: I move it be amended, Mr. Chairman,
20 to provide that we delete the word, State, and substitute
21 the word, who has not resided in the legislative district
