

1 legislative district from which he seeks election. This
2 does not mean that the election is by other than members
3 of the district. It just means that the members of the
4 district can elect a nonresident if they choose.

5 MR. MILES: Mr. Chairman, I move that in order
6 to be eligible to be a senator or delegate, the candidate
7 should have resided in the State and in the legislative
8 district which he seeks to represent for at least two
9 years.

10 THE CHAIRMAN: Dr. Bard?

11 DR. BARD: I think one is had enough. The
12 Committee felt that actually if the qualifications were
13 one year for residence in the State, there ought not be
14 any for residence in the area. Now, I personally feel and
15 I was opposed to the two-year limitation, I preferred
16 one, that if we are moving this up to two, we certainly
17 ought not make residence in the particular district any
18 more than one.

19 MR. MILES: I will accept that. My point is,
20 and my sole point, I think there is a strong feeling in
21 this State that anybody who represents the legislative
