2 this again?

3 MR. MILES: Yes. If you do not require the
4 county, the candidate to be a resident of the district
5 in which he seeks to represent --

6 MR. MINDEL: District or county?

7 MR. MILES: District. I am suggesting, this did
8 not originate with me but it is a parenthetical fact, as
9 an illustration, somebody in Harford County decided he
10 wanted to run for the Legislature, in a legislative dis-
11 trict which now comprises Cecil, Kent, Caroline and Talbot,
12 and that party hooks up with somebody from Cecil County
13 who is running in that district. You would have a
14 situation where candidates were running in two counties,
15 total population of which could be three times that of
16 all the rest.

17 THE CHAIRMAN: But he could do that if he were
18 a resident anywhere in the district. The fact he is a
19 resident in Harford County doesn't change that picture.

20 MR. MILES: Of course. Harford is not in that
21 district.
