6 mendation, rather than put it in the Constitution, and
7 accept Judge Adkins' point, indicating that the vacancies,
8 or that the law should provide so that the person appointed
9 shall be a member of the same political party, include that
10 but not indicate anything further in respect to the
11 nature of the law. What I mean is that the law might be
12 written so carefully so that it would take care of any
13 intervening elections, it would take care of special
14 situations, take care of temporary appointments.
