SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Chapter 590 of the Acts of 1987, as amended by Chapter 11 of the Acts of 1989

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That there shall be a Workers' Compensation Benefit and Insurance Oversight Committee consisting of the following members appointed by the President of the Senate of Maryland and the Speaker of the House of Delegates:

- (1) 2 members of the Senate of Maryland;
- (2) 2 members of the House of Delegates;
- (3) 1 representative of the Maryland business community;
- (4) 1 representative of [the Maryland] labor-organizations;
- (5) 1 representative of the Maryland building and construction labor organizations;
  - (6) 2 members of the public;
  - (7) 1 member of the insurance industry;
  - (8) 1 member of the medical and chirurgical faculty of Maryland; and
  - (9) 1 member of a workers' compensation rating organization.

The Chairman of the Oversight Committee shall be designated by the President of the Senate of Maryland and the Speaker of the House of Delegates.

The Workers' Compensation Benefit and Insurance Oversight Committee shall examine and evaluate the condition of the workers' compensation benefit and insurance structure in Maryland and the effect of this Act and of Chapter 591 of the Acts of 1987
