SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 83B - Department of Housing and Community Development 2-305.

- (a) The Nonprofit Rehabilitation Program is created within the Maryland Housing Rehabilitation Program.
- (b) (1) The Department shall operate the Program and make loans for rehabilitation projects to nonprofit sponsors under the provisions of this subtitle.
- (2) (I) THE DEPARTMENT, UNDER A DEMONSTRATION PROJECT, SHALL MAKE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE GRANTS TO NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS OR LOCAL GOVERNMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH A LOAN MADE UNDER THIS SECTION IF:
- 1. THERE IS CENSUS DATA OR OTHER INFORMATION THAT DEMONSTRATES A NEED FOR THE PROGRAM WITHIN THE REGION SERVED BY THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT OR NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION; AND
- 2. AN APPLICANT TO THE PROGRAM CAN BENEFIT BY RECEIVING TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE FROM A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT.
- (II) THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE GRANTS MAY NOT EXCEED 10 PERCENT OF THE BUDGETED PROGRAM FUNDS DURING ANY FISCAL YEAR.
- (III) THE DEMONSTRATION PROJECT SHALL TERMINATE ON JUNE 30, 1992.
