(a) (3) “Health care provider” means any of the following persons licensed or authorized to provide 1 or more health care services in the State:

- (i) A chiropractor[.];
- (ii) A dentist[.];
- (iii) A licensed practical nurse[.];

- (vi) A physical therapist[.];
- (vii) A physician[.];
- (viii) A podiatrist[.];
- (ix) A registered nurse[.]; OR
