

- No. 443. An act to repeal sections twenty-seven and twenty-eight of article fifty-six of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Licenses," sub-title "Hawkers and Peddlers," so far as the same applies to Anne Arundel county, and to enact two new sections to article two of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel County," under the new sub-title "Hawkers and Peddlers," to follow section 167, and to be designated as sections 167 A and 167 B. 634
- No. 444. An act to refund to William Burk, of Baltimore city, State of Maryland, the sum of \$65.65, paid by him for license, and which, with said boat, was lost in the Potomac river. 635
- No. 445. An act to repeal sections one to twenty-seven, both inclusive, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel county," sub-title "Almshouse," and chapter 166 of the Acts of 1892, and to re-enact said sections. 636
- No. 446. An act to refund to Mary A. Callahan a part of the oyster license fee paid into the State Treasury, for the "Schooner Shiloh." 641
- No. 447. An act to repeal chapters forty-nine and six hundred and seventy-nine of the acts passed at the January session, 1892, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Baltimore County," sub-title "Roads," and to re-enact the same with amendments. 641
- No. 448. An act to appropriate the fines and forfeitures imposed by the Circuit Court for Baltimore county, and by Justices of the Peace thereof, to the treasurer of the board of county school commissioners of Baltimore county, for the use of the public schools of said county. 653
- No. 449. An act to repeal and re-enact with amendments, sections 33 and 34 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Wicomico County," sub-title "Delmar." 653
- No. 450. An act to repeal section 11 of article 44 of the Code of Public General Laws, and to re-enact the same with amendments. 654
- No. 451. An act to authorize the mayor and council of Brunswick, in Frederick county, to issue bonds for the purpose of constructing, operating and keeping in repair, water works for said town, with the proviso that said issue of bonds be first approved by a vote of the people of said town of Brunswick. 656
