CHAPTER 166.

AN ACT, to authorize Joshua Stokes, John A. Martin and Joseph Willhide, Trustees of Primary School District number thirty two, in Frederick county, or their successors in office ; to sell and convey the Primary School House in North street, Mechanicstown, and apply the funds to rebuilding or in repairing a school-house in said town. Passed Feb. 18, 1864.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Joshua Stokes, John A. Martin and Joseph Willhide ; (Trustees of Primary School District number thirty-two,) or their successors in office, are hereby fully authorized to sell and convey the aforesaid school-house and lot or lots, and to apply the funds arising from the sale, in rebuilding or repairing the other primary school-house in said town.
