

be approved by the Orphans' Court of Frederick county, conditioned for the faithful custody of the moneys which shall be paid to him under this act, and to pay the same, with all interest which may be received thereon, over to said George Hill, in the event of said George Hill becoming free.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 184.

AN ACT to prohibit the issuing of any license for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors within three miles of either of the churches in the village of Myersville, Frederick county, Maryland, and to prevent the sale of all kinds of intoxicating drinks within the above described limits. Passed Feb. 18, 1864.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Frederick county shall not grant a license to any person to sell spirituous or fermented liquors of any kind, at any time or place within three miles of either of the churches in the village of Myersville, Frederick county, Maryland, and that any person selling any kind of intoxicating drinks, whether of original manufacture or of a mixed character, within the above described limits, shall on conviction be subject to all the fines and penalties prescribed by the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, for selling spirituous or fermented liquors without license. Not allowed to sell spirituous or fermented liquors.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after the first day of May next. In force.
